



Incoming International Exchange Students On-Campus Housing Information 2018-2019

Students from partner institutions studying abroad at Université de Nantes can request on-campus housing through the online application.

Attention: The number of places in the university residences is limited and we cannot guarantee to meet all the accommodation requests. To increase the chances of being placed in a university residence, students should apply early.

2. Reservation periods for university residences

Reservation periods are fixed and cannot be modified!

If a student decides to move out of his/her room before the end of the lease, he/she will be obliged to pay rent until the end of the lease.




 **Please Note:** Students can request to extend their accommodation booking period for the 2nd semester or for the summer for academic reasons only. Requests will be reviewed and they may only be granted based on vacancies at the period requested. More information will be available upon arrival in Nantes.

3. Room Assignments

 Students do not choose their residence halls. The staff at the International Relations Office of Université de Nantes will assign rooms to students depending on the availability of on-campus housing. No requests for changes in residence halls will be taken into account.

Students will receive a final answer regarding room assignments between **June 15th and 30th, 2018** for 1st semester and full year requests, and between **December 10th and 15th, 2018** for 2nd semester requests.

 **Room assignments are not definitive until the student confirms the reservation.**

4. Additional Information

The monthly rent must be paid directly at the university residence, before the 10th of each month.


Students can purchase a bedding kit upon their arrival at the residence hall. The kit costs 25 €*, and includes some sheets, one blanket, one pillow, one pillowcase.

In some residences, students can only purchase a disposable bedding kit for their first days in Nantes. This kit costs 15 €*.

5. Arriving at the University Residence

Students are allowed to move in only if they have subscribed to an **housing insurance** (a certificate will be required), and only if they can **pay the security deposit and the first rent upon arrival**.

 **Please Note:** In France, **an housing insurance is mandatory**; it has to be a French one. After the confirmation of the student's mobility period, he/she will receive by email the confirmation of the accommodation assignment and the link of a partner organism of Université de Nantes to subscribe to the housing insurance online.

Students are strongly **recommended to arrive on weekdays** (Monday to Friday / 8:30am-12pm and 1:30pm-4pm)

If you plan on arriving **outside these opening days and hours**, you must **inform the International Relations Office as soon as possible** in order for the residence to be informed and let you in.

Students **must come by the *Guichet Unique*** at the International Relations Office upon arrival, within the first days of their stay in Nantes <http://www.univ-nantes.fr/guichetunique>
